TANEL PADAR & BAND

Tanel Padar is one of the most popular and most sought after artists in Estonia in recent decades.

Tanel has won more than 20 music awards and has participated in almost every noteworthy Estonian music project over the past 15 years.

In 2001 he won the Eurovision Song Contest together with Dave Benton.

In 2016 he was awarded 2 Gold Records and decorated with the Order of the White Star by the Estonian president Toomas Hendrik Ilves.
