## Reflections on Three Decades of Sõrve... Rein Kiviväli

Summer 2003; Star Wars Episode II had been released, the 2nd instalment of Lord of the Rings had come out at Christmas, and I was attending camp for the 2nd time in my life. Having been once before, I was very excited. Knowing what the week had in store for me, with other kids from across the country who share a similar cultural background to myself. It was a week where I didn't have to spell out my name, and repeat "not Macedonian, E-stonian." Fast forward 10 years, and I'm a leader. Having been an Abijuht for 2 years, Sosin for 1 year, and even a year as an adult, on the self-titled "Jungle" veranda. During these years, the friends I made in my hut in 2003 have grown with me. The distance we need to travel to camp varies, but the memories we have created together are reflected upon and even more memories created. In 2019, I was fortunate enough to bring my wife and son to camp. Even though he was 7 months old at the time, he embarked on his 1st camp with 5 other first-time babies, and many other young C-groupers. The next generation attending camp (in some cases it's the 4th generation in the family) is the only proof you need to see of how strong the Sõrve Laager bond is in the Australian-Estonian community.
